Exploring the Ethnic Diversity of New York City and its Outer Boroughs is truly an Adventure!

Manhattan

Start with the ethnic diversity of New York City. The community of Harlem is the epicenter of African American life in Manhattan. Harlem is home to the famous Apollo Theatre, Abyssinian Baptist Church and the lovely historic neighborhoods of Sugar Hill and Striver's Row.

The Lower East Side of Manhattan is a proverbial melting pot of cultures and ethnicities. The arrival of waves of immigrants from the late 1800's through the 1950's formed one of the most colorful and unique areas of New York.

Feel the hustle and bustle of Chinatown, the largest Chinese community outside of China. Just across Canal Street is Little Italy, starting point for millions of Italian immigrants over the years. See how various ethnic groups have transformed Greenwich Village and Soho into thriving residential areas and centers of commerce.

Brooklyn

See the peoples of the globe in one day. See "Little Odessa" of Brooklyn better known as Brighton Beach home to the Russian community, the Polish neighborhood of Greenpoint, the Caribbean enclave of Flatbush, the Latinos of Sunset Park and the Pakistanis of Midwood. See the Hasidic Jewish communities of Crown Heights and Williamsburg. Explore the African American history of Bedford-Stuyvesant. Have a hot dog at the original Nathan's at Coney Island and visit the New York Aquarium.

Queens

Queens is also known as our most ethnically diverse borough. Explore the Greek neighborhood of Astoria, the Asian enclave in Flushing and the Indian community of Jackson Heights. Along with many other areas home to various ethnic groups including Eastern Europeans, Italians, Koreans, Israelis, Thais, Columbians, Irish, Peruvians, Japanese, etc. Ride the No. 7 train, also known as the "immigrant express". See the Former Worlds Fair in Flushing Meadow Park as well as Shea Stadium, home to the New York Mets.

Bronx

The borough at the northernmost tip of Manhattan Island is also known as the home of Yankee Stadium. This ethnically diverse borough features the New York Botanical Garden, the Bronx Zoo and its very own Little Italy.

Staten Island

Ethnic diversity is very much alive on the park like borough of Staten Island. Enjoy a scenic ride aboard the Staten Island ferry offering fabulous views of Manhattan and the Statue of Liberty. Visit Fort Wadsworth National Site one of the oldest military installations in the U.S. that has past protected the strategic southern entry point of New York Harbor.
