## New York City African American Heritage Tour

The epicenter of African American heritage in New York is to be found in Harlem, originally a Dutch farm settlement in the late 1600's.

Over the last few centuries Harlem has become the most famous African American neighborhood in the entire world.

We will tour 125<sup>th</sup> Street and visit a behind the scenes tour. We may be able to see an afternoon matinee or evening performance. The famous Apollo Theater which have featured some of the most famous African American musical icons such as Aretha Franklin, Nat King Cole, Duke Ellington, Count Basie and Marvin Gaye. We will have a behind the scenes tour. We may be able to see an afternoon matinee or evening performance.

Visit the Studio Museum housing the largest collection of African American Art in New York. The collection includes sculptures, paintings and photographs.

Visit the Abyssinian Baptist Church central to the African American community in Harlem since the late 1800's. Adam Clayton Powell once preached Canaan Baptist, Salem United Methodist and Metropolitan Baptist Churches. If we are in town on a Sunday, we will join the church for a memorable gospel service.

At the Schomburg Center for Black Research you may search for any type of African American literary work. The Schomburg Center is a division of the New York City public library system.

Your African American specialist guide will also introduce other various points of African American history such as the lovely historic neighborhoods of Sugar Hill and Striver's Row whose famous residents have included Sugar Ray Robinson, Count Basie and Thurgood Marshall.
